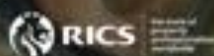

## BEFORE THE EVENT

**TIMES:** They will be emailed & will be available on BE website from 1800 on Thursday 24th september

**YOUR NUMBER: PRINT OFF THREE COPIES:** 2 for you; 1 for your lorry windscreen!

**COURSE WALK: AFTER 1400 ON FRIDAY** – Please Park at Blue gate and walk out onto the Coures (Turn Right on perimeter road for Start).

**DOGS ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES PLEASE**

## AT THE EVENT

**COMPETITOR CHECK IN:** At Princes Gate (Main entrance to the Showground)

- **DISPLAY YOUR NUMBERS:** We need the numbers of **ALL horses** in your lorry
- Each horse allowed **One Rider; One Support; and One Owner** (Two from the same household or two parents for U18 Riders if necessary)
- The number of people per horse will be noted
- **LORRIES:** Park 5 metres apart – tie up on one side. Horses must not be left unattended

**OWNERS CHECK IN:** At Princes Gate (Main entrance to the Showground)

- Please know your horse number and present your BE membership card
- One Owner per horse (or two from the same household)
- Cars will not be allowed in the Horsebox Park

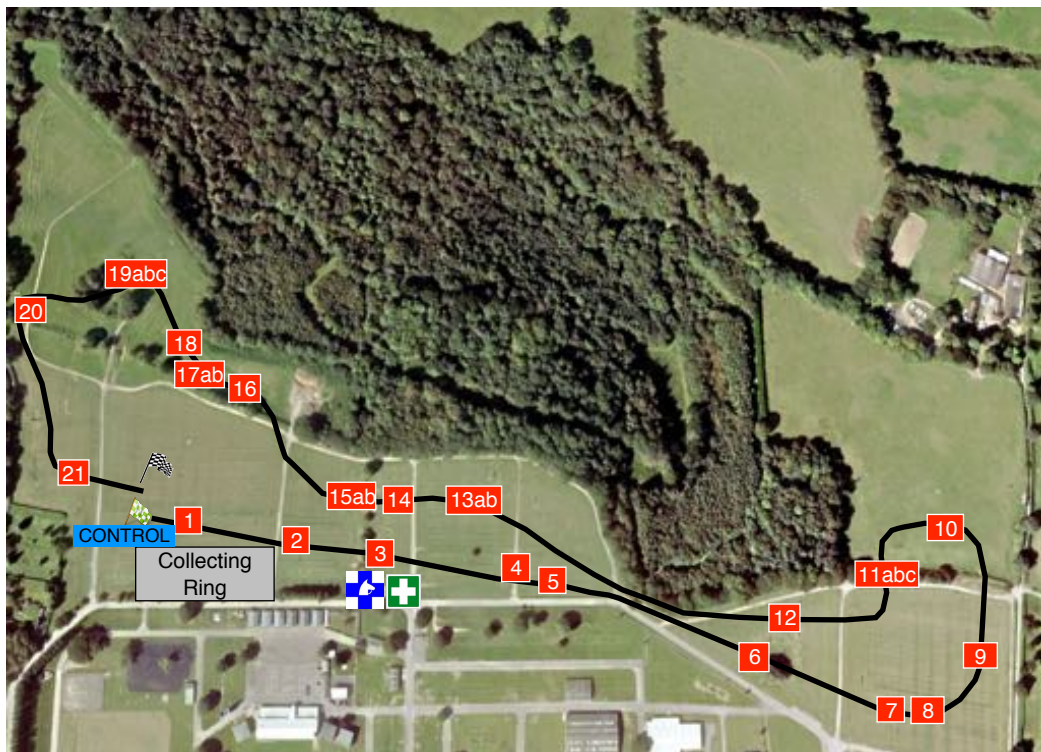

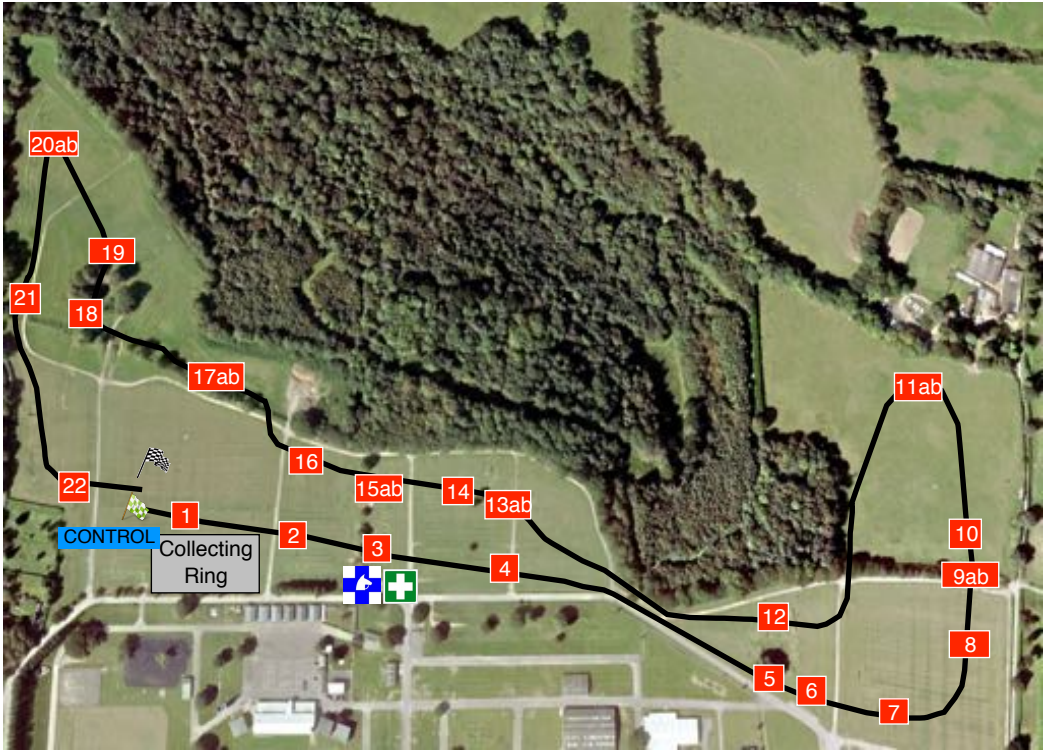

# HORSE TRIALS HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

## General

The Organiser of this horse trial, South Eastern Equestrian Services Limited, has the overall responsibility for the health, safety and welfare. A Safety Advisor, has been appointed also named elsewhere in the programme, to advise on all matters related to health, safety and welfare and to ensure that all the requirements of legislation are met.

## Officials

The Organisers, Officials and Judges and Stewards have the responsibility for the implementation of the Safety Policy throughout this event and must ensure the Health and Safety considerations are always given Priority.

## Spectators & Competitors

All reasonable and practicable steps are taken to ensure your health, safety and welfare whilst attending the event. You are requested to take note of the following

- a) You are advised to download a programme which contains a map showing the different parts of the event site(including suitable viewing locations)
- b) The programme also clearly shows the Information Point, Toilets and first aid points
- c) Please take particular note of any fencing, stringing, whistle blasts from officials, public address announcements and signage displayed.
- d) All drivers and vehicles must adhere to the highway code at the event

## Contractors
